Brampton pupils have been learning about how to keep themselves and others safe this term. Key Stage 2 pupils have had training in how to carry out lifesaving procedures including CPR and how to put an injured person into the recovery position. They have also practised putting slings on one another to support an injured or broken arm. At the end of the six weeks of training all the children will be competent in basic first aid and lifesaving skills.





In addition to the First Aid course our Junior Road Safety officers (JRSO) organised Beep Beep Day. This is an event that is promoted by the charity Brake. Our JRSO's planned and delivered lessons in every class in the school to raise awareness about how to keep safe near the road. Every child in the school placed their handprint on a banner that is going to be displayed outside the school to promote road safety outside the school.
