Pony Academy

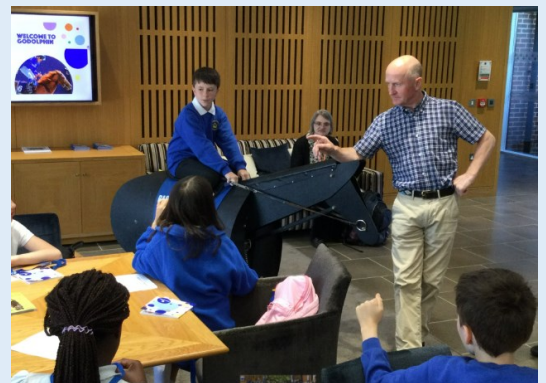


Year 6 have really enjoyed their Week at Pony Academy learning how to look after and ride a pony.
