a ceremony held at the Panathenaic Stadium in Athens (the site where the modern Olympics were first opened in 1896), the Olympic flame was passed to a delegation representing the country that will host the Games—for 2024, this is of course France.

The school looked at both the Olympic and Paralympic values discussing these in a School Assembly. The torch and flag were then taken outside and passed from pupil to pupil.
