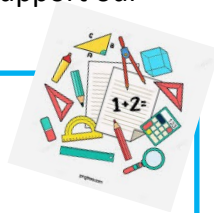

World of Work Maths Week 2025

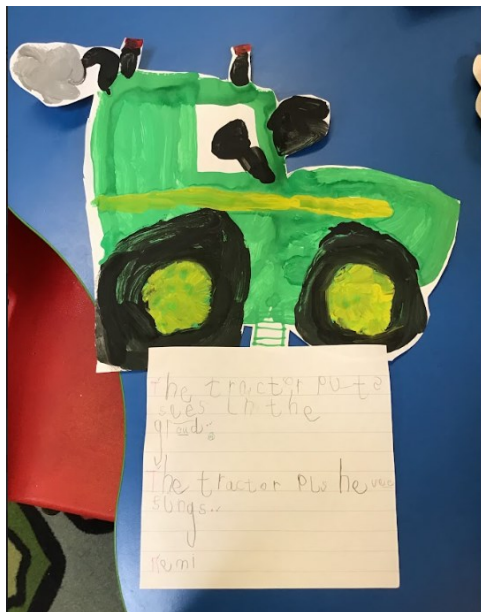

Signs of Spring: Baby Lambs Visit

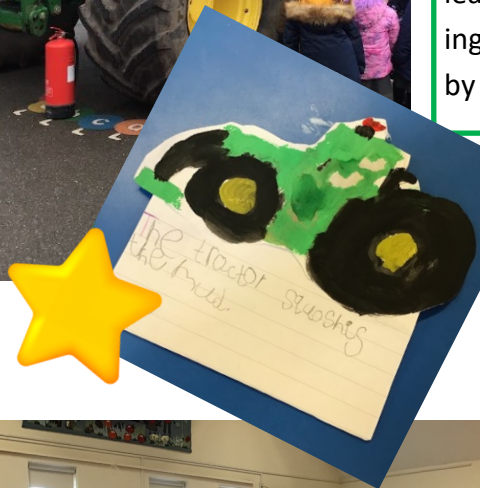
