To teach a class of KS2 pupils and the associated pastoral care and administrative duties in the respect of the children in the class as well as the general responsibilities in the school as agreed by the Headteacher. - To monitor and assess pupils' work, using these assessments to inform planning and set targets that promote continuity and progression.
- To ensure the individual needs of the pupils are met through differentiated work, allowing for the highest standards to be achieved by all.
- To liaise with both school support staff and external agencies in order to develop appropriate approaches in Special Educational Needs in respect of children in the class.
- To work in partnership with parents and other members of staff to promote the wellbeing and educational progress of each pupil.
- To follow school policies under the direction of the Head teacher.
- To work towards equal opportunities in both class and school and to be aware of the content and requirement of the relevant school policies.
- To report all safeguarding concerns to the DSL and adhere to all current policies and legislation.
- To mark the attendance registers.
- In accordance with the provisions of the current Health and Safety at Work Act, to take reasonable care for the health and safety of yourself, colleagues and pupils.
- To maintain good order and discipline within the class, in line with the school's behaviour policy.
- To actively take part in professional development, sharing expertise and experiences as required.
- To actively extend own professional learning via collaborative study, attendance at INSET and reading to keep abreast of new developments.

- To be responsible for a curriculum area/s (to be agreed).
- To support and advise colleagues, including the Headteacher, on the teaching of a curriculum area throughout the school.
- To assist in the organisation and maintenance of policy statements and documents when required.
- To contribute to, and where relevant lead, staff meetings on matters to do with the subject area.
