#### **Recycling Workshops**



Mr Ridsdale and some of our Year 6 pupils are part of the judging panel, selecting the winner of the Royal Society Young People's Book Prize. Such an honour!





The children in Reception visited an art exhibition in Christchurch Mansion and then created their own Art Gallery for parents to visit.








